#### ✓ Curricula development

Armenian partner universities met the Vice-Minister of the RA to discuss about the new decree regulating doctorate studies in Armenia and get advice about how to proceed with joint degrees. This is not clarified yet but universities can start planning based on existing rules. A meeting with EU partners was accorded in about 2 weeks.

In Kyrgyzstan, KSUCTA and KSMU sent proposals for new PhD curricula to the Ministry of Education, now they are under revision. OshTU is still preparing a proposal that will be sent to the Ministry very likely in September.

### ✓ Needs in research and development

KG partners distributed the questionnaires in Russian and English among industry and academy, so far 70 of them are collected. AM partners also distributed the questionnaires in 2 languages, in paper and online, 13 universities and 31 industry stakeholders have already responded. In both countries, a reminder and a deadline of 10-15 days will be sent to the rest of stakeholders.

A draft structure of the report of social needs is available <u>here</u>. All partners are welcome to suggest modifications until July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Then KSUCTA will complete the common sections with the collaboration of the rest of partners, until all answers arrive. The final report should be ready by the end of July.

#### ✓ National Research Nodes

KG partners showed the proposed list for Advisory Board (AB) of National Research Nodes (NRN) in GIT and this was approved. They will course a formal invitation together with a brochure describing the project. AM partners have a preliminary list that will be finished by  $1^{st}$  of July, then they will course invitation to the potential AB members. All partners will try to have a  $1^{st}$  meeting of the AB of the NRN-GIT before the end of July.

### ✓ Equipment

YSU already launched the procurement procedure for equipment purchase in different lots, to be open on June 28<sup>th</sup>. The tender announcement can be consulted <u>here</u>. ANAU and NUACA are working on the internal administrative procedures and they will launch the announcement soon. KSUCTA and OshTU signed an agreement to perform a joint procurement for the equipment purchase. KSMU is also preparing the tender process. In both cases they will start the process soon. All partners are strictly following their national laws.

# ✓ Quality Plan

VUB presented the Quality Plan draft, which will be available for comments and suggestions <a href="here">here</a> for 2 weeks. All partners should read it and comment it directly in the file. After these 2 weeks, the final document will be sent to EACEA and uploaded to the GeoTAK websites.

#### ✓ Dissemination





The local website in Armenia is almost translated and soon will start to hold local news and documents of the project. In Kyrgyzstan they are purchasing the domain for 10 years and will be devoted both, to the project, and to the promotion of the NRN-GIT.

NUACA and KSUCTA are preparing brochures to be distributed among AB members, stakeholders and society.

Next PMM will be in September, but during July EU partners will maintain brief meetings with KG and AM partners for monitoring curricula development and other specific issues.
