

Explain internal and external mechanisms

Clarify how the recruitment of external expert(s) is organised

EQUIPMENT

Explain where the purchase stands in each institution (ex: tender launched, contract awarded, invoice received...)



To be eligible, equipment has to be purchased 12 months before the end of the project

No conflict of interest and transparency in purchases/tenders/ subcontracts

Do not split the purchase of equipment to avoid a tender



REQUEST FOR PAYMENT 1/2

- Attach pdf version of the "Statement on the use of the previous pre-financing instalment and Request for payment" (Sheet 1 Excel Table)
- > Signed by Legal Representative
- ➤ 2nd pre-financing payment of 40% of the grant specified in Article I.3.1, if 70% of the previous pre-financing has been spent





REQUEST FOR PAYMENT 2/2

Art I.5.2

If 70% of the first pre-financing not spent, the second payment will be reduced by the difference between the amount spent and the ceiling of 70%.

If the statement on the use of the previous pre-financing instalment submitted in accordance with Article I.4.2 shows that less than 70 % of the previous pre-financing instalment paid has been used to cover costs of the action, the amount of the new pre-financing to be paid must be reduced by the difference between the 70 % ceiling and the amount used. 49
